- to demand from the State of Equatorial Guinea the immediate and unconditional release of Mr. ANACLETO Micha Ndong and the other activists arbitrarily detained in prisons in Equatorial Guinea;

To scrupulously respect

- the African Charter on Human and Peoples' Rights;
- the Maputo Protocol on the Protection of Women ;
- the African Charter on Democracy, Elections and Governance (ACDEG) ;
- the Guidelines on Conditions of Arrest, Police Custody and Pre-trial Detention in Africa;
- the Declaration of Principles on Freedom of Expression and the Press in Africa.
